## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

One representative from nominations by the--National Council--on-Alcoholism--in-Maine,--Incorporated, a statewide alliance for addiction recovery appointed by the Governor; 8 10 **SUMMARY** 12 This bill changes one membership position on the Substance Abuse Services Commission from nominations from the National 14 Council on Alcoholism in Maine Incorporated, which is no longer functioning, to nominations from a statewide alliance for 16 addiction recovery.
