Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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CONCEPT DRAFT SUMMARY

This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

This bill proposes to make improvement grants available to help agricultural fairs develop a comprehensive long-term marketing plan. The grants are limited to improvements and upgrades to internal roadway, drainage, waste and potable water systems and power distribution systems necessary to expand an agricultural fair. The grants may be made for marketing and to make major capital improvements.
