22	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the

30	<u>A veterinarian licensed in this State may sell rabies</u> vaccine to a person who owns cattle, sheep, goats or domesticated
32	deer as defined in section 1331. A veterinarian who sells rabies vaccine in accordance with this section is not, as a
34	result of selling the vaccine, liable for claims arising from the administration of the vaccine by the purchaser.

administering antibiotics, vitamins and vaccines to treat medical
conditions or promote the health of that person's livestock. For the purposes of this subsection, "livestock" means cattle,
equines, sheep, goats, swine, llamas, poultry, rabbits and domesticated deer as defined in Title 7, section 1331.'

## SUMMARY

10 This amendment allows a person who owns cattle, sheep, goats or deer to purchase rabies vaccine directly from a licensed veterinarian. A veterinarian who sells rabies vaccine to a livestock owner is not liable for claims arising from the administration of the vaccine. An animal vaccinated against rabies by a person who is not a licensed veterinarian or under the supervision of a licensed veterinarian may not be certified as vaccinated against rabies. This amendment includes livestock owners among those authorized to possess hypodermic apparatuses.
