	SUMMARY
30	This amendment strikes the provision of Committee Amendment
32	"A" that prohibits a person from using an automated external defibrillator, or AED, unless that person places a call to the
34	appropriate emergency services personnel. Instead, this amendment prohibits the use of an AED unless the person is able
36	to communicate with emergency personnel and those emergency personnel are able to reach the scene of the emergency in a
38	reasonable period of time.
