	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec.1. 17-A MRSA §558 is enacted to read:
•	§558. Adultery
8	 A person is guilty of adultery if the person engages in a sexual act with a person who is not the actor's spouse and:
10	A. The actor is married; or
12	B. The actor is not married and knows that the other person involved in the act is married.
14	2. Adultery is a Class D crime.

18	SUMMARY
20	This bill makes adultery a Class D crime. Adultery is
22	defined as engaging in a sexual act with a person not the actor's spouse when either the actor is married, or the actor is not married and knows the other person is married.
