
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1092, L.D. 1461, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Health Insurance Benefits Available to Retired Legislators"

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph F in the last line (page 2, line 14 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "paragraph G" the following: 'A person who was a member of the 120th Legislature who does not reach 62 years of age by January 1, 2003 may not elect to continue coverage under this paragraph'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph G in the last line (page 2, line 23 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "paragraph." the following: 'A person who was a member of the 120th Legislature who does not reach 62 years of age by January 1, 2003 may not elect to continue under or rejoin the group health plan under this paragraph.'

SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits a person who was a member of the 120th Legislature from electing the health insurance coverage option provided by the bill. This bill does not prevent a member of the 120th Legislature who is eligible for coverage under existing law from receiving that coverage.
