HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1092, L.D. 1461, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Health Insurance Benefits Available to Retired Legislators"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary 20 the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The bill allows Legislators who terminate legislative 26 service with at least 8 years of creditable service to continue coverage in the State's employee health insurance program at their own expense and allows them to be eligible for the retiree 28 health insurance program at the time that they do retire. It 30 further allows Legislators with at least 8 years of creditable service who retire after a break from legislative service to make 32 a one-time election at retirement to continue under or rejoin the group health plan. These actions will increase the future cost 34 of the retiree health insurance program. The impact of these additional costs on the employee health insurance rate and the fiscal year in which the additional costs will occur can not be 36 determined at this time and will depend on the number of 38 individuals who take advantage of these options and the year in which they retire. The impact of these options on individuals' 40 retirement decisions can not be determined.

 The State's employees health insurance program will incur minor additional costs to administer a separate program for
Legislators who have terminated their legislative services and continue to pay their health insurance premiums. The program is
authorized to assess the participants in this group for the additional administrative costs.'
