4 **84.** Centers for innovation. Sales to centers for innovation as described in Title 5, section 13141.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

12 The Maine Science and Technology Foundation and centers for innovation may realize some minor savings from the change in the charter of the Maine Science and Technology Foundation from minor differences in administrative responsibility and continuation of a sales tax exemption, respectively.'

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the original bill by striking reference to both the Maine Technology Institute and other centers for innovation that may be established by the Commissioner of Economic and Community Development. It also adds a new section that preserves the sales tax exemption for the centers for innovation that has been available to them as subsidiary entities of the Maine Science and Technology Foundation. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
