SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
1097, L.D. 1466, "Resolve, to Study the Benefits and Costs for
Increasing Access to Family and Medical Leave for Maine Families"

20 Amend the amendment on page 2 in subsection 2 in the 2nd
line (page 2, line 30 in amendment) by striking out the
following: "may:" and inserting in its place the following: 'may
22 hold up to 4 meetings. At those meetings, the commission may:'

24 Further amend the amendment on page 2 in subsection 2 by
striking out all of paragraph C (page 2, lines 38 and 39 in
26 amendment)

28 Further amend the amendment on page 2 in subsection 2 by
relettering the paragraphs to read consecutively.

30 Further amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting after
32 paragraph F (page 2, line 49 in amendment) the following:

34 'Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 7
and inserting in its place the following:

38 'Sec. 7. Compensation. Resolved: That the members of the
commission who are Legislators are entitled to the legislative
40 per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3,
section 2, and reimbursement for necessary expenses incurred for
42 their attendance at authorized meetings of the commission. No
other member of the commission is entitled to receive
44 reimbursement of expenses incurred for that member's attendance
at authorized meetings unless outside funds are received for this
purpose in accordance with section 9 of this resolve; and be it
46 further' '

2 Further amend the amendment in the first indented paragraph
on page 3 in the 3rd line (page 3, line 3 in amendment) by
4 striking out the following: "December 1" and inserting in its
place the following: 'December 31'

6 Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section
10 and inserting in its place the following:

8
10 'Sec. 10. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds
are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
of this resolve.


46 The amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by
\$4,400 by allowing the reimbursement of nonlegislative members
only if outside sources of funding are received, eliminating the
48 requirement for a survey and clarifying meeting provisions.

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1097,
L.D. 1466

As amended, the Legislature will require an additional
General Fund appropriation of \$1,640 in fiscal year 2001-02 for
the per diem and expenses of legislative members of the
Commission to Study the Benefits and Costs for Increasing Access
to Family and Medical Leave for Maine Families and to print the
required report.

SUMMARY

This amendment reduces the cost of the resolve by giving
nonlegislative members of the study commission expenses only if
outside funds are received by the study commission for that
purpose. The amendment also allows the study commission to hold
up to 4 meetings. The amendment removes the requirement that the
commission conduct a survey of the public or affected persons and
groups.
