SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1098, L.D. 1467, Bill, "An Act to Facilitate the Implementation of the Enhanced 9-1-1 Emergency System"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 7 the following:

'Sec. 8. Construction. This Act may not be interpreted to prohibit the State Police from providing facilities or other assistance for the operation of public safety answering points.'
