SENATE AMENDMENT "C' to H.P. 1098, L.D. 1467

FISCAL NOTE

If the Joint Standing Committee on Utilities and Energy is 6 able to conduct the required review as part of its authorized and budgeted interim committee meetings, the costs associated with the review can be absorbed by the Legislature within existing 8 budgeted resources. If the committee is required to meet solely for the purpose of conducting a government evaluation review, the 10 Legislature will require additional General Fund appropriations 12 for Legislators' per diem and expenses and to hold public While the exact amount of funding can not be hearings. determined, the estimated cost of per diems and expenses only for 14 one meeting of the full committee is \$1,365.

SUMMARY

20 This amendment requires the Joint Standing Committee on Utilities and Energy to conduct a State Government evaluation of 22 the enhanced 9-1-1 emergency system in 2001.
