New Initiative: Provides funds to create a digital library to
meet the educational, research, business and economic needs of
Maine. The funds will provide for information resources in
digital form, such as books, scholarly journals, publicly
accessible Internet sites, databases, electronic archives and
other information sources. The Maine State Library and the
Raymond H. Fogler Library at the University of Maine will
cooperatively provide access technology as well as licensing
agreements to acquire publicly available databases.

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This bill includes an Other Special Revenue Funds allocation of \$500,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 2002-03 for the University of Maine System to create a digital library. The amendment also instructs the Public Utilities Commission to order the National Exchange Carrier Association to transfer \$500,000 by June 30, 2002 and \$500,000 by June 30, 2003 from the unexpended balance of the telecommunications education access fund to the University of Maine System for the infrastructure needs associated with the creation of a digital library.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment requires the Public Utilities Commission to order the National Exchange Carrier Association to transfer funds from the telecommunications education access fund to the University of Maine System for the infrastructure needs associated with creating a digital library. This amendment also makes changes to the provisions of law that address the uses and guidelines for the telecommunications education access fund. It also adds an appropriation and fiscal note to the bill.
