4 The Legislature will require additional General Fund appropriations of \$1,215 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$1,725 in 6 fiscal year 2002-03 for the per diem and expenses of legislative members and other eligible members of the Commission to Respond 8 to the Crisis in Access to Oral Health Services for Residents of the State and to print the required report.

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The additional costs associated with providing staffing 12 assistance to the commission during the interim between legislative sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing 14 existing budgeted resources. If an extension of the reporting deadline is granted and the commission requires staffing 16 assistance during the legislative session, the Legislature may require an additional General Fund appropriation to contract for 18 staff services.

20 The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to serve on the Commission to Respond to the 22 Crisis in Access to Oral Health Services for Residents of the State. These costs can be absorbed within the department's 24 existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment amends the resolve. It decreases the 30 membership on the Commission to Respond to the Crisis in Access to Oral Health Services for Residents of the State by 3 32 Legislators and removes compensation and reimbursement for expenses for nonlegislative members. It changes the report date 34 to November 1, 2002. The amendment also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the resolve.
