Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 **Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §621-A, sub-§4.** as enacted by PL 1999, c. 790,
Pt. P, §1 and affected by §3, is amended to read:

6 **4. School personnel.** Employees of a school administrative
unit who work the school year schedule may, upon written
8 agreement ~~with the employer~~ between the employees and the school
administrative unit, be paid for their work during the school
10 year over a period of 10 months or 12 months. For purposes of
this subsection, "written agreement" includes but is not limited
12 to a collective bargaining agreement.

16 **SUMMARY**

This bill amends current law to allow school year employees
18 to receive their pay over a period of either 10 or 12 months, as
determined by a written agreement between the employees and the
20 school administrative unit.
