Be it	enacted	by	the	People	of th	e State	of	Maine	as	follows:
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Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §621-A, sub-§4. as enacted by PL 1999, c. 790, Pt. P, §1 and affected by §3, is amended to read:

4. School personnel. Employees of a school administrative unit who work the school year schedule may, upon written agreement with-the-employer between the employees and the school administrative unit, be paid for their work during the school year over a period of 10 months or 12 months. For purposes of this subsection, "written agreement" includes but is not limited to a collective bargaining agreement.

SUMMARY

This bill amends current law to allow school year employees to receive their pay over a period of either 10 or 12 months, as determined by a written agreement between the employees and the school administrative unit.
