COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1112, L.D. 1481, Bill, "An Act to Permit the Ten Commandments to be Posted in Public Schools"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The estimated cost of sending this measure out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the 120th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November, 2002. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$121,392. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$8,000.'

**SUMMARY**

This is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
