COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1116, L.D. 1485

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The increase in the school bus inspection fee would result 12 in a total increase to the local school administrative units' transportation program costs of approximately \$24,744 based on 14 the fact that currently 50% of the public school fleet is inspected in privately owned inspection stations. Of that 16 amount, approximately \$15,342 would be subsidized by General Purpose Aid for Local Schools. This increased cost would be 18 absorbed by the local school administrative units within their transportation program budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

24 This amendment changes the definition of "private school activity bus" to clarify that these buses must be constructed to 26 meet or exceed all relevant federal motor vehicle safety standards. The amendment also clarifies that private school 28 activity buses are required to comply only with the school bus provisions regarding mirrors and fire extinguishers. It also 30 adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
