members and other eligible members of the Commission to Develop 2 and Finance Health Care Coverage for All Maine People, to hold public hearings and to print the required report.

The additional costs associated with providing staffing 6 assistance to the commission during the interim between legislative sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing 8 existing budgeted resources. If an extension of the reporting deadline is granted and the commission requires staffing assistance during the legislative session, the Legislature may 10 require an additional General Fund appropriation to contract for staff services. 12

14 The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to serve on the Commission to Develop and 16 Finance Health Care Coverage for All Maine People and to provide staffing assistance as needed. These costs can be absorbed 18 within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

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## **SUMMARY**

This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The 24 amendment adds 2 members to the Commission to Develop and Finance Health Care Coverage for All Maine People: a member representing 26 health maintenance organizations and health plans and a member representing small employers with fewer than 50 employees. The 28 amendment deletes the reference to rural health centers and replaces it with the correct reference to community health centers. The amendment also clarifies that the duties of the 30 commission include addressing ways to alleviate the burden of increasing costs on employers, particularly small employers. 32

34 The amendment also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.

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
