13           use funds from a congregate housing services program, to the  
14           extent available, to fund the 75 units of occupied low-income  
15           affordable congregate housing that are funded by the United  
16           States Department of Housing and Urban Development's HOPE for  
17           Elderly Independence Demonstration Program funds that terminate  
18           in September 2001.
