HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1126, L.D. 1523, Bill, "An Act to Preserve the Right to Air-dry Laundry"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 6 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 6 and 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "municipality or person may not enact or impose an ordinance," and inserting in its place the following: 'person may not impose a'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 6 in the last line (page 1, line 9 L.D.) by inserting after the following: "purposes," the following: 'This subsection may not be construed to prohibit a municipality from prohibiting the hanging of laundry outdoors.'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provision in the bill that prohibited a municipality from prohibiting the hanging of laundry outdoors.
