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This resolve includes General Fund appropriations of \$168,000 and \$168,000 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively, for the Long Term Care - Human Services program within the Department of Human Services due to the exclusion of spousal income in the calculation of the copayment for consumer-directed, home-based care lowering the portion of the cost that must be contributed by the consumer.'
