HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1156, L.D. 1556, Bill, "An Act to Protect Children from Internet Pornography"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~S4009-A.~~" by striking out all of the first indented paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'An elementary or secondary school in the State may not allow any person to access obscene, pornographic or other material through the use of a computer or computer server of the school.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 3 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 16 and 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "a person under 18 years of age" and inserting in its place the following: 'any person'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 3 in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 18 and 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "that may be harmful to a person under 18 years of age"

SUMMARY

This bill forbids elementary and secondary schools and school, state, institutional and public libraries from allowing any person from accessing obscene or pornographic materials through the use of the schools' or libraries' computers.
