This bill also includes General Fund appropriations of 20 \$3,897,484 and \$3,993,425 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively, for the Department of Human Services to amend its 22 rules of reimbursement for residential care facilities to ensure the reimbursement reflects the current cost of providing services.

Also included in this bill are General Fund appropriations of \$1,049,306 and \$1,045,708 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively, for the Department of Human Services to amend its rules to remove the homebound requirement that currently applies to Medicaid home health coverage.

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This bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$237,608 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$236,793 in fiscal year 2002-03 for the Department of Human Services to amend its rules regarding the principles of reimbursement to nursing facilities and residential care facilities to remove any provision that reduces the total reimbursement of fixed costs because of low occupancy.

38 This bill also includes Federal Expenditures Fund allocations of \$3,394,159 and \$3,421,157 in fiscal years 2001-02 40 and 2002-03, respectively, for the federal match.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment removes provisions of the bill related to operation of the Certified Nursing Assistant Registry, Medicaid reimbursement for nursing facilities and home health care services, quality standards and processes within the Medicaid long-term care program, transfer of assets and spousal impoverishment protections and an aging-in-place study. The

amendment appropriates \$150,000 per year for technology and staff for the Certified Nursing Assistant Registry. It also adds an appropriation section, an allocation section and a fiscal note to the bill.

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
