This is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee 8 on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. It clarifies that it is unlawful to operate a motor vehicle other than a snowmobile and 10 appurtenant equipment at any time of the year on a snowmobile trail that is financed in whole or in part with funds from the 12 Snowmobile Trail Fund. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
