Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the State has no medical school and it appears that creation of such a school can help relieve the present shortage of physicians and ensure an adequate future supply of physicians and make conveniently available to the citizens of this State the increasingly complex and effective facilities of a modern medical school center; and

12 Whereas, the State must now rely on the generosities of its sister states to educate Maine physicians; and

Whereas, the funds must be made available as soon as 16 possible so that Medical Care Development, Inc. may be hired and commence it study; and

- Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
