### 8 '§12743. Health Workforce Retraining Program

10 The president and the chancellor shall establish the Health Workforce Retraining Program for the purpose of making education and training programs available under section 12743 to eligible 12 businesses and organizations, including, but not limited to, hospitals, long-term care facilities and other health care 14 facilities, to support the training and retraining of health care employees to address changes in the health care workforce. The 16 education and training programs must be established on the basis 18

- of need for workers in a particular area of health care.
- 1. Rules established. The president and the chancellor 20 shall adopt rules to establish:
- A. Criteria for eligible health care businesses and 24 organizations;
- 26 B. Guidelines for the establishment of education and training programs through a request-for-proposal procedure; 28 and
- C. Procedures for establishing a matching grant program 30 allowing state funds to match contributions from the private 32 sector.

34 2. Program lapses. The Health Workforce Retraining Program is based on a 50-50 partnership between the State and the private 36 sector. If, by June 30, 2003, there are no funds from the private sector to be matched by state funds, the program expires 38 and all state funds lapse to the General Fund.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated 40 "**§12744.**" by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following: 42

44 '1. Establishment. The Health Care Training Fund, referred to in this section as the "program fund," is established as a 46 dedicated fund to be directed and administered by the president and the chancellor and held by the Treasurer of State. The Treasurer of State shall keep the program fund segregated from 48 all other funds held by the Treasurer of State and shall invest and reinvest the program fund for the benefit of the Health 50

Workforce Retraining Program.'

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated 4 "<u>§12744.</u>" by striking out all of subsection 3 and inserting in its place the following:

- '3. Application of program fund. Money in the program fund 8 must be continuously applied by the president and the chancellor to carry out this section and may not be used for any other 10 purpose.'
- 12 Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>\$12745.</u>" in the indented paragraph in the first line (page 3, 14 line 10 in L.D.) by striking out all of the following: "<u>of the</u> <u>system</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>and the</u> 16 <u>chancellor</u>'

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $\beta$ " to S.P. 505, L.D. 1592

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This bill includes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$100,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 for the Office of Treasurer of State for transfer as necessary to the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System and the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical College System to establish a new education and training program that requires a one-to-one match from private funds. If matching funds are not raised by June 30, 2003, the program expires and all state funds lapse to the General Fund.

10 The additional costs associated with adoption of rules to establish the new education and training program can be absorbed 12 by the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System and the Board of Trustees of the Technical College System utilizing 14 existing budgeted resources.'

### SUMMARY

18 This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. The amendment eliminates the Health Careers Incentive Program and changes the 20 Health Workforce Retraining Program from a grant program 22 available to eligible health care businesses and organizations to a matching grant program that establishes education and training 24 programs for eligible health care businesses and organizations dollar-for-dollar matching that provide funds and meet 26 eligibility criteria established by rules of the Maine Technical College System and the University of Maine System. The amendment 28 also provides a one-time appropriation of \$100,000 in fiscal year 2002-03 to establish the Health Care Training Fund for use by the Maine Technical College System and the University of Maine System. 30 32 This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
