
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1180, L.D. 1603, Bill, "An Act to Expand Family Life Education in Maine Schools"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 1-A in the 5th line (page 1, line 37 in amendment) by striking out the following: "age" and inserting in its place the following: 'developmentally' and in the 5th line from the end (page 1, line 41 in amendment) by striking out the following: "sexual behavior" and inserting in its place the following: 'behavior regarding sexuality'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "§1910." in the first paragraph in the last line (page 2, line 7 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "programs" the following: 'or other community service providers'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that comprehensive family life education must be developmentally appropriate and promote responsible behavior regarding sexuality with an emphasis on abstinence. The amendment also includes other community service providers in the category of agencies with which the Commissioner of Human Services may contract.
