34	family life education" means education in kindergarten to grade 12 regarding human development and sexuality, including education
36	on family planning and sexually transmitted diseases, that is medically accurate and age appropriate; that respects community
38	values and encourages parental communication; that develops skills in communication, decision making and conflict resolution;
40	that contributes to healthy relationships; that promotes
42	responsible sexual behavior with an emphasis on abstinence; that addresses the use of contraception; that promotes individual
	responsibility and involvement regarding sexuality; and that
44	teaches skills for responsible decision making regarding sexuality.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "" to H.P. 1180, L.D. 1603

SUMMARY

4 This amendment replaces the bill and its title. It directs the Commissioner of Human Services to undertake initiatives in order to expand and enhance comprehensive family education services. It strengthens the language on abstinence. It removes 8 specific reference to the Family Planning Association of Maine.

10 It removes the reference to learning results. It allows a parent to not have that parent's child participate in a 12 comprehensive family life education program. It removes the appropriation section. It adds a fiscal note.

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
