W. 4 S.

This bill requires municipalities to assume capital and maintenance responsibility for all minor span bridges that are on town ways. The additional costs of this state mandate could be relatively significant to certain municipalities; the amounts can not be determined at this time. Pursuant to the mandate preamble, the 2/3 vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.

Beginning in fiscal year 2001-02, the net impact of realigning capital and maintenance responsibilities for local bridges will result in annual Highway Fund savings of \$1,100,000 to the Department of Transportation.'

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16 SUMMARY

This amendment adds a mandate preamble, an allocation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
