HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1205, L.D. 1627, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Equality in Mental Health Coverage"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 27 the following:

Sec. 28. Transfer of funds. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, at the close of fiscal year 2002-03 the State Controller shall transfer \$1,137,217 from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Rainy Day Fund in the Department of Administrative and Financial Services.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment would transfer \$1,137,217 from the General Fund to the Maine Rainy Day Fund at the close of fiscal year 2002-03. This amount is the total net deappropriation in fiscal year 2002-03 achieved in the bill as amended by Committee Amendment "B."


