	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1997, c.
4	643, Pt. OO, §1 and affected by §3, is repealed and the following
_	enacted in its place:
6	3. Payment by State. The State shall pay a portion of
8	retired teacher members' share of this insurance as follows:
10	A. For retired teacher members with a household income less than 60% of the federal poverty level, 50%;

44	For purposes of this subsection, "federal poverty level" means

30	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2002.

J#	This bill increases the amount of the portion of retired
36	teachers' health insurance paid by the State from the current amount of 30% to an amount up to 50%, based on the household
38	income of the retired teacher.
