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SENATE AMENDMENT "*A*" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.
514, L.D. 1633, Bill, "An Act to Clarify Rights of Retainage in
Public Construction Contracts"

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Amend the amendment in subsection 2 in the 9th line (page 1,
line 35 in amendment) by inserting after the following:
"reduced" the following: 'in accordance with the contract
payment schedule'

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Further amend the amendment by inserting after subsection 2
the following:

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'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and
inserting in its place the following:

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'**Sec. 2. Application.** This Act applies to public construction
contracts entered into on or after the effective date of this
Act.' '

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FISCAL NOTE


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The amendment revises the retainage payment and application
provisions for public improvements contracts such that a state
mandate no longer exists.

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SUMMARY

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This amendment clarifies that the payment of retainage for
punch list work is to be made in accordance with the contract
