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#### **SUMMARY**

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	This amendment is the majority report of the committee. It
4	removes the provisions for tax credits in the original bill. It
	retains a grant program for licensed professional foresters to
6	assist with costs of obtaining 3rd-party certification as forest
	resource managers. It appropriates \$5,000 to establish the
8	certified forest resource manager grant fund. It also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.

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
