COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1220, L.D. 1661

of Falmouth, the Town of Raymond and the Town of Windham are 2 elected on the mutually coincident municipal elections within these-tewns in the Town of Cumberland, the Town of Falmouth and the Town of Windham in June, but, if there is not a mutually 4 coincident municipal election date, then on the 2nd Tuesday of 6 June. The Town of Raymond shall hold a special town meeting to elect the trustees on the same day that the Town of Cumberland, 8 the Town of Falmouth and the Town of Windham hold their coincident municipal elections to elect the trustees from those towns. Costs for any trustee election held concurrently with a 10 federal, state or municipal election are divided between the 12 municipality and the district. When there is a division of costs, the district is responsible for the costs proportional to 14 the total number of offices and referenda issues voted upon at the election. If an election for a trustee results in a tie 16 vote, the other trustees shall select the person who becomes a trustee.' 18

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 7 the 20 following:

'Sec. 8. Transition. Trustees of the Portland Water District 22 elected by a plurality of the voters of the towns of Cumberland, Falmouth and Windham prior to the effective date of this Act and 24 serving on the effective date of this Act continue to serve until 26 their successors are elected and take office in accordance with this Act.'

## **'FISCAL NOTE**

This bill requires the Town of Raymond to hold a special The additional costs of this state mandate are 36 town meeting. likely to be relatively minor. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the 2/3 vote of all members elected to each House exempts the 38 State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.' 40

This amendment adds a mandate preamble to the bill and a transition clause relating to the current trustees of the 46 The amendment also incorporates a Portland Water District. change made by Private and Special Law 2001, chapter 7 that 48 changes the date of the regular municipal elections from May to November. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill. 50
