COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 1222, L.D. 1663, Bill, "An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$17,200,000 to Construct and Upgrade Water Pollution Control Facilities, to Remove Discharges, to Remediate Municipal Solid Waste Landfills, to Clean up Tire Stockpiles, to Make Drinking Water System Improvements and to Develop Municipal Digital Data Layers and Maps"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$17,200,000 to Construct and Upgrade Water Pollution Control Facilities, to Remove Discharges, to Remediate Municipal Solid Waste Landfills, to Clean up Tire Stockpiles, to Make Drinking Water System Improvements and to Assist Municipalities in Building and Upgrading Infrastructure for Public Health and Safety'

Further amend the bill in the preamble in the last line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "develop municipal digital data layers and maps" and inserting in its place the following: 'upgrade municipal facilities through the Municipal Investment Trust Fund'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 11th and 12th lines (page 1, lines 22 and 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "develop municipal digital data layers and maps" and inserting in its place the following: 'upgrade municipal facilities through the Municipal Investment Trust Fund'

2 Further amend the bill in section 5 in the last line (page
2, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
4 "Administrative and Financial Services" and inserting in its
place the following: 'Economic and Community Development'

6 Further amend the bill in section 6 in the 4th and 5th lines
(page 2, lines 11 and 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
8 "**develop municipal digital data layers and maps**" and inserting in its
place the following: '**upgrade municipal facilities through the**
10 **Municipal Investment Trust Fund**'

12 Further amend the bill in section 6 by striking out all of
that part designated "**ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL**
14 **SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF**" (page 2, lines 45 and 46 and page
3, lines 1 to 4 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

16 '**ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT,**
18 **DEPARTMENT OF**

20 Grants and loans to municipalities \$2,000,000
for public infrastructure through
22 the Municipal Investment Trust Fund'

24 Further amend the bill in section 10 in the question in
subsection 4 in the 2nd line (page 4, line 3 in L.D.) by striking
26 out the following: "the replace" and inserting in its place the
following: 'and replace'

28 Further amend the bill in section 10 by striking out all of
subsection 7 and inserting in its place the following:

32 '7. The sum of \$2,000,000 to assist municipalities in
building and upgrading infrastructure for public health and
34 safety through the Municipal Investment Trust Fund.'

36 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
summary the following:

40 **FISCAL NOTE**

42 The estimated cost of sending this bond issue out to
referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda
44 enacted during the First Regular Session of the 120th Legislature
to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to
46 the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is
\$121,392. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$8,000.

2 If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue
is estimated to be \$21,305,640 with principal payments of
4 \$17,200,000 and interest payments of approximately \$4,105,640.'

6 **SUMMARY**

8 This amendment is the majority report. It replaces that
10 portion of the bond issue that provided \$2,000,000 to prepare
municipal digital data layers and maps with a provision that
12 provides \$2,000,000 in grants and loans to municipalities for
public infrastructure through the Municipal Investment Trust Fund.

14 The amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
