HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1224, L.D. 1665, Bill, "An Act to Further Reduce Mercury Emissions from Consumer Products"


Amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "S1661-A." in subsection 1 in the 10th line (page 2, line 25 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "section." the following: 'The requirements of this section do not apply to drugs approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration.'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "S1661-B." by inserting after the first paragraph a new paragraph to read:

'The requirements of this section do not apply to drugs approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the disclosure requirements of the bill do not apply to drugs that are approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration.
