## **'FISCAL NOTE**

The Department of Professional and Financial Regulation will incur some minor additional costs to adopt rules granting a hardship deferment for a professional who fails to meet continuing education requirements due to a death or serious illness in the person's family. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

**SUMMARY** 

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Business and Economic Development. The amendment allows a licensing authority under the jurisdiction of the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation to grant hardship deferments for continuing education requirements. What constitutes an undue hardship is left to the discretion of the licensing authority. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
