These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.' 36 38 SUMMARY 40 This amendment enacts language to allow the Commissioner of 42 Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to sell general merchandise and accept donations of money, goods and services. The amendment 44 allows individuals under 10 years of age to participate in hunting as long as they do not carry a firearm. The amendment removes sections of the bill concerning commercial shooting 46 areas, lifetime licenses, open deer seasons, point systems and 48 effective dates. Additionally, the amendment repeals warranty requirements for registering snowmobiles and all-terrain

vehicles. The amendment clarifies when a person may shoot from a motorboat and adds language to clarify a citation.
