COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1252, L.D. 1700

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, the Department of Conservation, the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources and the Atlantic Salmon Commission will incur some minor additional costs to pool resources for the purpose of monitoring and managing conservation easements. These costs can be absorbed within the agencies' existing budgeted resources.

The State Planning Office within the Executive Department will incur some minor additional costs to coordinate the state monitoring and management of conservation easements. These costs can be absorbed within the office's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the bill to a resolve. It changes the title and encourages certain state agencies to pool existing resources to monitor and manage conservation easements they hold. It also directs the Executive Department, State Planning Office to the extent practicable within existing resources to coordinate the state monitoring and management of conservation easements.
