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## **COMMITTEE AMENDMENT**

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 560, L.D. 1722

Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act takes effect on the date that the Department of Human Services begins offering prescription drug benefits under the Maine Rx Program as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 2681.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE** 

12 The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to publicize the names of the pharmaceutical companies that participate and do not participate in the Maine Rx Program. These costs can be absorbed within the department's 16 existing budgeted resources.'

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**SUMMARY** 

This amendment removes from the bill all provisions except 22 those pertaining to the reporting of information regarding manufacturers and labelers of prescription drugs that participate 24 and do not participate in the Maine Rx Program. The amendment adds a provision making the Act effective on the date that 26 prescription drug benefits are provided under the Maine Rx Program. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
