20	Act to Clarify Laws Pertaining to the Permit Process for Wildlife Possession"
22	Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clauge and
24	before section 1 the following:
26	'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7077, sub-§1-A, $\P G$, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 136, §1, is repealed.'
28	Further amend the bill in section 7 in the 2nd line (page 1,
30	line 23 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "wildlife" the following: ' <u>in captivity</u> '
32	Further amend the bill in section 7 in that part designated
34	" <u>§7235-C.</u> " in subsection 1 by striking out all of the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 25 and 26 in L.D.) and inserting in its
36	place the following:
38	'1. Affected species. Except as otherwise provided in this Part, this section applies to the possession of any wildlife
40	regulated by the State that is held in captivity and to the importation of wildlife from an area outside the State,

44	Further amend the bill in section 7 in that part designated "§7235-C." by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 2, lives 15
46	to 24 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
48	'3. Fees. Permit fees are as follows:
50	A. Propagation, \$25 for 2 calendar years;

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2 B. Commercial exhibition or attracting trade, \$145 every 2 years from July 1st to June 30th; Δ C. Personal use, professional or vocational husbandry, б. therapy or aid to disabled persons, \$25 every 2 calendar years; and 8 D. Notwithstanding section 7456, the 3. 28 commissioner may issue permits to persons licensed under section 7235-A 7235-C to take rock doves from the wild by the use of box traps or nets for the purpose of training sporting dogs pursuant 30 to this section and section 7863. 32 Sec. 17. 12 MRSA §7863, sub-§5, ¶A, as amended by PL 1993, c. 438, §43, is further amended to read: 34 A. Notwithstanding this section, the commissioner may issue 36 a permit to any person authorizing the use of firearms during the training of sporting dogs to shoot and kill wild 38 birds propagated or legally acquired by the permittee and 40 possessed in accordance with section 7235-A 7235-C. Sec. 18. 12 MRSA §7901, sub-§3-A, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 42 89, $\S2$, is repealed. 44 Sec. 19. 12 MRSA §7947, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is repealed.' 46 Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any 48 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively. 50

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will incur some minor additional costs to adopt certain rules pertaining to 8 the permit process for wildlife possession. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources. 10

The establishment of certain permit fees for wildlife 12 possession will result in insignificant increases of General Fund revenue collected by the department.' 14

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the fee structure for permits to 20 possess wildlife and corrects cross-references. This amendment also clarifies which species are affected by the bill. It also 22 adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
