SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 568, L.D. 1732, Bill, "An Act to Establish for an Additional Two Years the Commission to Study the Needs and Opportunities Associated with the Production of Salmonid Sport Fish in Maine"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 3rd indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the bill in Part B in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 3, line 24 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "members" the following: '; meetings'

Further amend the bill in Part B in section 2 in subsection 2 in the last line (page 3, line 38 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the bill in Part B in section 2 by inserting after subsection 2 the following:

'3. The Speaker of the House shall appoint a member of the House to the commission who is the House chair. When making this appointment, the Speaker of the House shall give preference to a House member of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife; and'

Further amend the bill in Part B in section 2 by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill in Part B in section 2 by inserting at the end a new paragraph to read:

'Upon completion of all appointments, the chairs shall call  
and convene the first meeting of the commission, which must be  
held no later than August 15, 2001.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 4th  
indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the bill in Part B in section 5 in the first  
2 lines (page 4, lines 33 and 34 in L.D.) by striking out the  
following: "The legislative members and ad hoc members" and  
inserting in its place the following: 'Members who are  
Legislators'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section  
B-8 and inserting in its place the following:

**'Sec. B-8. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from  
Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.



a per diem for attendance at commission meetings to Legislators.
