2           **Sec. 1. Resolve 1997, c. 105, §4, amended. Resolved:** That Resolve  
3 1997, c. 105, §4, as amended by PL 1999, c. 790, Pt. D, §12, and  
4 affected by §13, is further amended to read:

5           **Sec. 4. Reports. Resolved:** That the MCJUSTIS Board shall  
6 submit ~~interim reports and proposed legislation to the joint~~  
7 ~~standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction over~~  
8 ~~criminal justice matters and judiciary matters by January 1, 1999~~  
9 ~~and January 1, 2000.~~ The MCJUSTIS Board shall submit a final  
10 report and proposed legislation amending the Maine Revised  
11 Statutes, Title 17-A to the Legislature and the joint standing  
12 committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction over criminal  
13 justice matters and judiciary matters by January 31, 2001. The  
14 MCJUSTIS Board shall submit proposed legislation amending other  
15 criminal and civil violations to the Legislature and to the joint  
16 standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction over  
17 criminal justice matters and judiciary matters by December 15,  
18 2001 and December 15, 2002. The proposed legislation must  
19 accomplish the purpose of this resolve without making additional  
20 substantive changes to the Maine Revised Statutes. The MCJUSTIS  
21 Board may recommend additional legislation. Each committee may  
22 report out additional legislation related to the report.

23           **Sec. 2. Retroactivity.** That section of this resolve that  
24 amends Resolve 1997, c. 105, §4 applies retroactively to January  
25 31, 2001.

30           This resolve amends the reporting requirements for the  
31 MCJUSTIS Board to clarify that the board submits its final report  
32 and proposed legislation amending the Maine Revised Statutes,  
33 Title 17-A by January 31, 2001. This resolve also amends the  
34 board's reporting requirements to specify that the board submit  
35 proposed legislation amending other civil and criminal violations  
36 to make them compatible with computerized databases by December  
37 15, 2001 and December 15, 2002. The retroactivity section makes  
38 these changes retroactive to January 31, 2001.
