42	FISCAL NOTE
44	The Bureau of Medical Services within the Department of
46	Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to adopt rules associated with prior authorization for prescription drugs
48	under the Medicaid program. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

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## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 572, L.D. 1744

This estimate assumes that the prior authorization for the prescription drugs program continues to operate during the rule-making process. The Governor's proposed "current services" budget proposal includes General Fund savings of \$3,127,703 and \$3,688,086 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively, associated with the prior authorization for the prescription drugs program. A delay or discontinuance of this program would result in either a partial or total loss of these savings.'

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## **SUMMARY**

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This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services. It replaces the bill. It provides a new title. It requires the Department of Human Services to adopt rules by November 1, 2001 regarding prior authorization for prescription drugs under the Medicaid program. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
