COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 576, L.D. 1754, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws of the Maine State Retirement System"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1, 3, 6 and 15.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The additional costs associated with certain amendments to the laws of the Maine State Retirement System can be absorbed by the System utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment deletes the sections from the bill that establish the Maine State Retirement System as a single retirement plan for financial reporting and administration purposes.

It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
