Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1954 is enacted to read: 4 §1954. Smoking cessation program 6 The department shall administer a smoking cessation program 8 to provide information and incentives for pregnant women to cease or significantly decrease the amount of tobacco that they smoke and to decrease the by-products of tobacco that they ingest. The 10 program must provide information regarding smoking status, 12 testing and cessation programs for health care providers and testing for smoking status of pregnant women. The program also 14 provides information, smoking cessation aids, including pharmacological aids, and incentives for pregnant women. . The 16 program must include an evaluation component that includes the rates at which pregnant women smoke and the percentages of babies 18 born with low birth weights. 20 **SUMMARY** 22 This bill requires the Department of Human Services to 24 establish a smoking cessation program to decrease and eliminate smoking among pregnant women.
