SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 579, L.D. 1757, Bill, "An Act to Encourage Savings for Higher Education"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 7th line from the end (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after "education" the following: 'whether or not'

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment does not affect the total funds available but, because the awards are "needs based," the amendment may affect the number of scholarships awarded and the amount of the award to students attending schools in Maine.

SUMMARY

This amendment makes clear that the beneficiary of a program account under the Maine College Savings Program need not attend a Maine-based institution of higher education.
