18	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 585, L.D. 1761, Bill, "An
20	Act to Enhance Governance of the Allagash Wilderness Waterway"
22	Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:
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26	'Resolve, Establishing the Committee to Study and Make Recommendations to Enhance the Governance of the Allagash Wilderness Waterway'
28	- Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the
30	title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:
32	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
34	Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
36	Whereas, the Allagash Wilderness Waterway was established by
38	the Maine Legislature in 1966 as a pristine recreational and scenic wilderness area to be preserved for enjoyment by future
40	generations of Maine citizens and visitors; and
42	Whereas, the Allagash Wilderness Waterway was designated as a state-owned and state-managed "wild" component of the National
44	Wild and Scenic Rivers System in 1970 in recognition of the outstanding recreational values of the waterway; and
46	Whereas, in January 1999, after 2 years of work and after
48	significant public comment, the Department of Conservation

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adopted a management plan for the waterway to quide its 2 operations over the next 10 years; and

Whereas, some are now questioning the consistency of the State's management of the waterway since the early 1970s with its 6 · designation under the federal Wild and Scenic Rivers Act and the State's enabling statute and feel that further legislative guidance is needed to guide the department's management of this important resource; and

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Whereas, this resolve establishes a legislative committee to study the issues relating to the Allagash Wilderness Waterway; and 12

14 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 16 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it 18

Sec. 1. Committee established. Resolved: 20 That the Committee to Study and Make Recommendations to Enhance the Governance of the Allagash Wilderness Waterway, referred to in this resolve as the 22 "committee," is established; and be it further

Sec. 2. Committee membership. Resolved: That the committee consists of 15 members as follows: 26

28 The President of the Senate shall appoint 2 Senators; 1. the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint 5 When making the appointments, the House. the 30 members of President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House shall each appoint at least one member of a party that does not hold the 32 majority of seats in that body, and they shall give preference to members who serve on the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, 34 Conservation and Forestry. Furthermore, when making the appointments, they each shall appoint at least one Legislator who 36 represents a legislative district that includes land within the Allaqash Wilderness Waterway; 38

The Director of the Northeast Region of the National 40 2. Park Service or the director's designee;

3. The chair of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission or the chair's designee; 44

The Commissioner of Conservation or the commissioner's 46 4. designee;

The Governor shall appoint 5 public members to the 5. committee as follows: 50

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- A person representing a landowner who owns land adjacent to the waterway;
 - B. A person who resides in either Northern Penobscot County, Piscataquis County or Aroostook County;
- 8 C. A person representing the interests of sportsmen;
- 10 D. A person representing commercial guides; and
- 12 E. A person representing environmental interests; and be it further

Sec. 3. Committee chairs. Resolved: That the first named Senator is the Senate chair of the committee and the first named member of the House is the House chair of the committee; and be it further

Sec. 4. Appointments; convening of committee. Resolved: That all appointments must be made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this resolve. The appointing authorities shall notify the Executive Director of the Legislative Council once all appointments have been made. When the appointment of all members has been completed, the chairs of the committee shall call and convene the first meeting of the committee, which must be no later than August 1, 2001; and be it further

Sec. 5. Duties. Resolved: That the committee shall gather 30 information and request necessary information from public and private entities on the history and establishment of the Allagash 32 Wilderness Waterway, including the history of the State's application for and federal acceptance of wild river status, the 34 State's management of the waterway and the implementation of the provisions in the 1999 Allagash Wilderness Waterway Management Plan relating to foot and vehicular access and structures in view 36 of the waterway's enabling statute and its status as a 38 state-owned and state-administered component of the National Wild and Scenic River System. The committee shall hold a minimum of 5 40 meetings at locations to be determined by the chairs. Geographic locations of meetings must be chosen to accommodate participation by landowners and people using the Allagash Wilderness Waterway; 42 and be it further

Sec. 6. Staff assistance. Resolved: That, upon approval of the Legislative Council, the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis shall provide necessary staffing services to the committee. The Legislative Information Office shall provide clerical support to the committee, including sending notice of all meetings

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of the committee to all members of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. Upon request by the chairs, the Department of Conservation shall provide information and other services to the committee relating to the Allagash Wilderness Waterway; and be it further

Sec. 7. Compensation. Resolved: That legislative members of the committee are entitled to receive the legislative per diem as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2 and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses related to their attendance at authorized meetings of the committee. Other members of the committee not otherwise compensated by their employers or entities that they represent are entitled to receive reimbursement of necessary expenses for their attendance at authorized meetings of the committee; and be it further

Sec. 8. Report. Resolved: That the committee shall submit a report that contains its findings and recommendations, including 18 any necessary implementing legislation, to the Second Regular 20 Session of the 120th Legislature no later than December 5, 2001. The report must make recommendations regarding the statutes governing the Allagash Wilderness Waterway, the 1999 management 22 plan for the waterway and the waterway's designation under the 24 federal Wild and Scenic Rivers Act, 16 United States Code, Sections 1271 to 1287. If the committee requires a limited 26 extension of time to complete its study and make its report, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant an extension. Upon submission of its required report, the committee 28 terminates; and be it further


Sec. 9. Budget. Resolved: That the chairs of the committee, with assistance from the committee staff, shall administer the 32 committee's budget. Within 10 days after its first meeting, the committee shall present a work plan and proposed budget to the 34 Legislative Council for approval. The committee may not incur 36 expenses that would result in the committee's exceeding its approved budget. Upon request from the committee, the Executive 38 Director of the Legislative Council shall promptly provide the committee chairs and staff with a status report on the committee's budget, expenditures incurred and paid and available 40 funds: and be it further

Sec. 10. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

40	The additional costs associated with providing staffing assistance to the committee during the interim between
42	legislative sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources. If an extension of the reporting
44	deadline is granted and the committee requires staffing assistance during the legislative session, the Legislature may
46	require an additional General Fund appropriation to contract for staff services.
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50	The Department of Conservation will incur some minor additional costs to participate in the Committee to Study and

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Make Recommendations to Enhance the Governance of the Allagash Wilderness Waterway and to provide assistance to the committee. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the bill to a resolve and establishes 10 the Committee to Study and Make Recommendations to Enhance the Governance of the Allagash Wilderness Waterway. It also adds an 12 appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.

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
