HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1295, L.D. 1765, Bill, "An Act to Authorize Release of Certain Information Pertaining to the Certification, Authorization and Approval of Educational Personnel"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 12 the following:

**Sec. 13. Removal of applicant's fingerprints from state repository.** Within 90 days of the effective date of this Act, the Department of Public Safety, State Bureau of Identification shall remove from the state repository the fingerprints collected from those educational personnel who were subject to the requirements of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, former section 6103. The State Bureau of Identification shall return all such fingerprints collected and any related material, including copies or other information or files, to the subject of the fingerprinting or the next of kin.

**Sec. 14. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

information files to certain educational personnel.

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### SUMMARY

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36 This amendment requires the Department of Public Safety,  
State Bureau of Identification to remove from the state  
repository the fingerprints collected from educational personnel  
who were subject to the requirements of the Maine Revised  
38 Statutes, Title 20-A, former section 6103 and return the  
fingerprints and any related materials to the subject of the  
40 fingerprinting or the next of kin. This amendment adds an  
appropriation to cover the costs of the return.
