Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the 2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 davs after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 4 Whereas, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A requires legislative authorization before major 6 substantive agency rules may be finally adopted by the agency; and 8 Whereas, the above-named major substantive rule has been 10 submitted to the Legislature for review; and 12 Whereas, immediate enactment of this resolve is necessary to record the Legislature's position on final adoption of the rule; and 14 16 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 18 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it 20 Sec. 1. Adoption. Resolved: That the final adoption of Chapter 22 55.58: Penobscot River Fishing Closure, a provisionally adopted major substantive rule of the Department of Marine Resources, 24 that has been submitted to the Legislature for review pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A 26 is authorized. 28 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 30 preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved. 32 **SUMMARY** 34 36 This resolve provides for legislative review of Chapter 55.58: Penobscot River Fishing Closure, a major substantive rule 38 of the Department of Marine Resources.
